



Fright Crew Rules

General

- Do not touch the props, sets, or displays unless instructed to do so by a manager.
- Do not use any tool, prop, or piece of equipment without first receiving proper instruction in its use. You must be over 18 to use power tools, or operated an animatronic or mechanical prop.
- Familiarize yourself with the layout of the building and the locations of the exits and fire extinguishers. In the event of a fire or other emergency requiring evacuation, immediately leave the building. If you encounter anyone while exiting you may instruct them to follow you to safety. Once outside, go to your assigned meeting point and check in with a manager.
- No drugs or alcohol on the premises. Do not participate while under the influence.
- Smoking, vaping, and dipping permitted only in designated areas and at specified times.
- No rough housing or horse play.
- Treat your fellow crew members with courtesy and respect. Avoid inappropriate language.
- Clean up after yourself. Throw trash away and put tools, supplies, and other equipment away.

Nights of Operation

- Notify a manager ahead of time if you will not be at the haunted house on a scheduled night, will be late, or have to leave early.
- Arrive at the haunted house one hour before opening time, earlier if your role requires extensive costuming, make-up, and/or other preparations.
- Sign in when you arrive, sign out if you have to leave early. This is so we can account for everyone in the event of an emergency.
- Be in your assigned spot 15 minutes prior to opening time. This is when the managers will begin their final walkthrough to address any last minute issues and questions.
- Wear all black unless otherwise instructed. Don't forget your shoes and socks.
- Silence your cell phones. Avoid phone calls and texting while the haunt is in operation. If cell phone communication is absolutely necessary, keep it discrete and out of sight of the guests.
- Report any problems to patrolling managers when they visit your area. In the event of an emergency notify a manager or security immediately.
- Do not touch the guests. Always keep at least an arms length distance between you and the guests in case a guest lashes out as a fright response.
- Stick to the script and instructions for your character/scene. Discuss potential changes with a manager.
- Always stay in character except in the event of an emergency.
- Give every guest your best performance.
- At the end of the night clean up any trash in your scene and return your costume, mask, and props to their proper storage areas.
